

## INDEPENDENT AUDIT REPORT

## Scope

We have audited the Community Benefits Statement of the Royal Oak Richmond for the year ended 30 June, 2007. These procedures have been undertaken to form an opinion on whether, in all material respects, the Community Benefit Statement is presented fairly in accordance with the requirements of the Gambling Regulation Act 2003.

The audit opinion expressed in this report has been formed on the above basis.
