### INDEPENDEDNT AUDITOR'S REPORT TO THE COMMITTEE OF MORDIALLOC SPORTING CLUB INCORPORATED.

#### Scope

We have audited the accompanying Community Benefit Statement ("the Statement") of Mordialloc Sporting Club Incorporated for the year ended 30 June 2021. The Statement has been prepared by the Committee of Management based on the requirements of the Gambling Regulations Act 2003.

#### Committee's responsibility

#### **Auditor's Responsibility**

Our responsibility is to express an opinion on whether the Community Benefit Statement prepared by the Mordialloc Sporting Club Incorporated in all material respects, has been prepared in accordance with the requirement of Sections 3.6.9(2)(a) and (b) of the Gambling Regulations Act 2003

We conducted our audit in accordance with Australian Auditing Standards. Those standards require that we comply with relevant ethical requirements relating to audit engagements and plan and perform the audit to obtain reasonable assurance whether, in all material respects, Community Benefit Statement has been prepared in accordance with applicable Accounting Standards in Australia and sections 3.6.9 (2)(a) and (b) of the Gambling Regulations Act 2003.

An audit involves performing procedures to obtain audit evidence about the amounts and disclosures in the Community Benefit Statement. The procedures selected depend on the auditor's judgment, including the assessment of the risks of material misstatement of the Statement, whether due to fraud or error. In making those risk assessments, the auditor considers internal control relevant to the Committee's preparation of the statement to design audit procedures that are appropriate in the circumstances, but not for the purpose of expressing an opinion on the effectiveness of the entity's internal control. An audit also includes evaluating the appropriateness of accounting policies used and the reasonableness of accounting estimates made by the committee
