

INDEPENDENT AUDITOR'S REPORT TO FOSTER GOLF CLUB INC.

We have audited the compliance of Foster Golf Club Inc. with the requirements of sections 3.6.9(2) (a) and (b) and section 3.6.9 (3) of the *Gambling Regulation Act 2003* in relation to the Community Benefit Statement for the financial year ended 30 June 2025.

Committee's Responsibility

The procedures performed are dependent on the auditor's judgment and have been undertaken to form a conclusion as whether Foster Golf Club Inc. has complied, in all material respects, with sections 3.6.9(2) (a) and (b) and section 3.6.9 (3) of the *Gambling Regulation Act 2003*.

We have complied with all ethical requirements in accordance with ASAE3100.

The audit conclusion expressed in this report has been formed on the above basis.
