Scope


My audit has been conducted in accordance with Australian Auditing Standards, in particular, Australian Auditing Standards, 'The Audit Report on Financial Information Other than a General Purpose Financial Report', AUS802, Statement of Auditing Practice, 'Audit Independence', AUP32 and in accordance with sections 3.6.9(2)(a) and(b) of the Gaming Regulation Act 2003, to provide reasonable assurance as to whether the Community Benefit Statement is free of material misstatement. Our procedures included examination of evidence supporting the amounts, and significant accounting estimates.

The audit opinion expressed in this Report has been formed on the above basis.

Audit Opinion

In my opinion, the Community Benefit Statement presents fairly:

-  The application of gaming revenue to community purposes of a kind determined by the Minister for Gaming
-  The value of non-financial contributions from gaming revenue to the community purposes of a kind determined by the Minister for Gaming
- That the required community benefit contribution is greater than the 8 1/3% of the venue operator's share of the gaming revenue for the period 1st July 2018 to 30th June 2019.
