

Independent audit report to the members of The Queenscliff Bowling Tennis Croquet Association Inc.

Scope

We have audited the Community Benefits Statement of the Queenscliff Bowling Tennis and Croquet Association Inc. for the year ended 30 June 2014. The organization's management is responsible for the Community Benefit Statement and have determined that the accounting policies used are appropriate and in accordance with the requirements of the Gambling Regulation Act 2003 administered by the Victorian Commission for Gambling and Liquor Regulation (VCGLR). Our audit has been conducted in accordance with applicable Australian Auditing Standards to provide reasonable assurance that the Community Benefit Statement is free of material misstatement. Our procedures included examination, on a test basis, of evidence supporting the calculation of amounts and other disclosures in the Community Benefit Statement, and the evaluation of accounting policies and significant accounting estimates used. These procedures have been undertaken to form an opinion on whether, in all material respects, the Community Benefit Statement is presented fairly in accordance with the requirements of the Gambling Regulation Act 2003.


The audit opinion expressed in this report has been formed on the above basis.

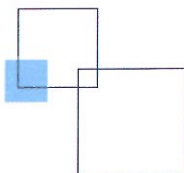
